Dear Michigan Works! Agency (MWA) Directors:

Enclosed, for your information, is the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Quarterly Performance Report for the second quarter of Program Year (PY) 2009. This report includes performance results for all 17-performance measures listed below plus data for the new youth common measures. Each of the 19 tables identifies the time period used for the data in the table. Tables 1 through 12 and tables 15 and 18 utilize wage record data provided by employers. Tables 13, 14 and 19 utilize information provided by the WIA Management Information System. Customer satisfaction survey information is used to complete tables 16 and 17.

Available data indicates that Michigan met its planned performance levels for the Adult and Dislocated Worker programs for the second quarter of PY 2009, but failed the Younger Youth Diploma or Attainment Rate (Table 14).

Table 1 displays the adult entered employment rate data. Four MWAs failed to achieve at least 80 percent of their planned performance level for this measure. Table 2 reveals the employment retention rate at six months data. One MWA failed this performance measure. Table 3 shows the adult average earnings in six months data. All MWAs exceeded or met their planned performance levels for this adult performance measure. Table 4 provides data on the adult employment and credential/certificate rate. Three MWAs failed to achieve this measure.

Table 5 displays the dislocated worker entered employment rate. One MWAs failed to meet 80 percent of their planned performance level for this measure. Table 6 indicates the employment retention rate at six months performance levels. One MWA failed this measure. Table 7 shows the dislocated worker average earnings in six months data. All MWAs exceeded or met their planned performance levels for this dislocated worker performance measure. Table 8 provides data on the dislocated worker employment and credential/certificate rate. All MWAs exceeded or met their planned performance levels for this dislocated worker employment and credential/certificate rate performance measure.

Table 9 displays the older youth entered employment rate data. Ten MWAs failed this performance measure. Table 10 provides the older youth employment retention rate at six months data. Four MWAs failed to achieve at least eighty percent of their planned performance level for this performance measure. Table 11 shows the older youth earnings change in six months data. Six MWAs failed this performance measure. Table 12 provides data on the older youth credential/certificate rate. Eleven MWAs failed to achieve their planned performance level.

Table 13 presents data on the younger youth skill attainment rate. Two MWAs failed this performance measure. Table 14 shows the younger youth diploma or equivalent attainment rate. Seven MWAs and the State failed this measure. Table 15 provides performance data on the younger youth retention rate at six months. Six MWAs failed to achieve their planned performance measure.

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Tables 16 and 17 provide participant and employer customer satisfaction survey results. All MWAs exceeded or met their planned performance level.

Table 18 displays data for two of the new youth common measures. The statewide average for the youth placement in employment or education rate was 48.9 percent. The youth attainment of a degree or certificate rate for the state was 41.0 percent. Table 19 provides data on the third new youth common measure. The youth literacy and numeracy gains performance measure for the second quarter of PY 2009 was 23.1 percent.
